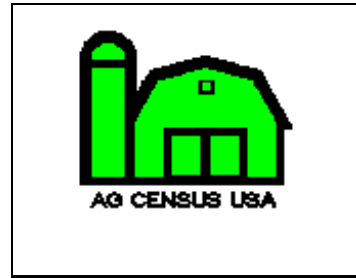


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## ADAIR OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 9 percent from 207,333 acres in 1992 to 225,322 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased slightly from 206 acres in 1992 to 207 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased slightly from 472 farms in 1992 to 476 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

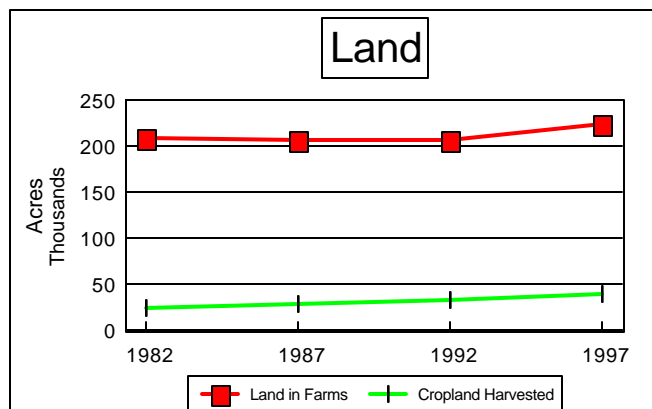
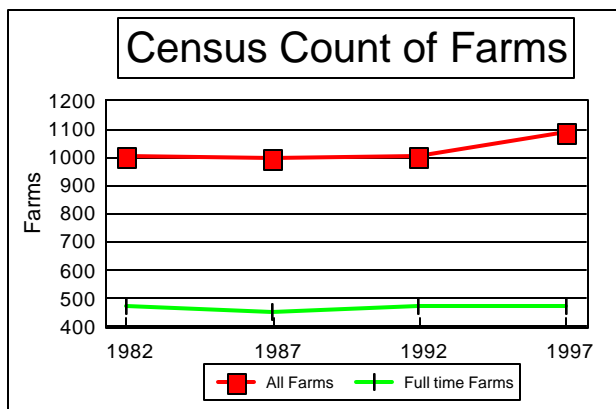
Decreased 16 percent to \$74,320,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 2 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 98 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 22 percent from \$87,828 in 1992 to \$68,183 in 1997.
