Increased 3 percent from 157,105 acres in 1992 to 162,308 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 12 percent from 181 acres in 1992 to 160 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 7 percent from 334 farms in 1992 to 356 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

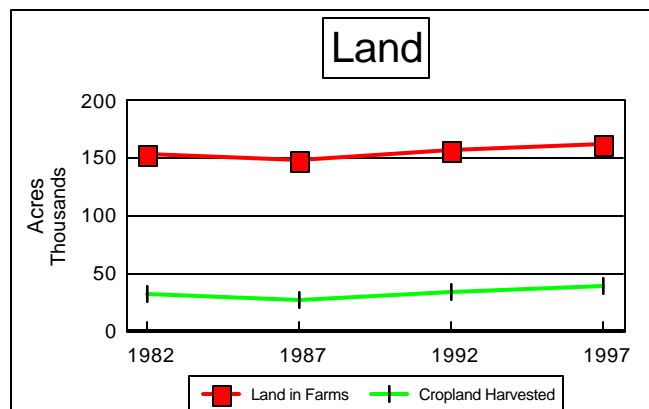
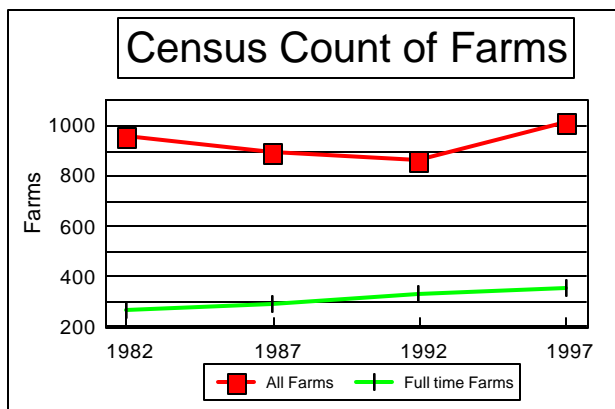
Decreased 4 percent to \$12,173,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 32 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm
