Increased 3 percent from 264,890 acres in 1992 to 272,894 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 6 percent from 494 acres in 1992 to 466 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 298 farms in 1992 to 281 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

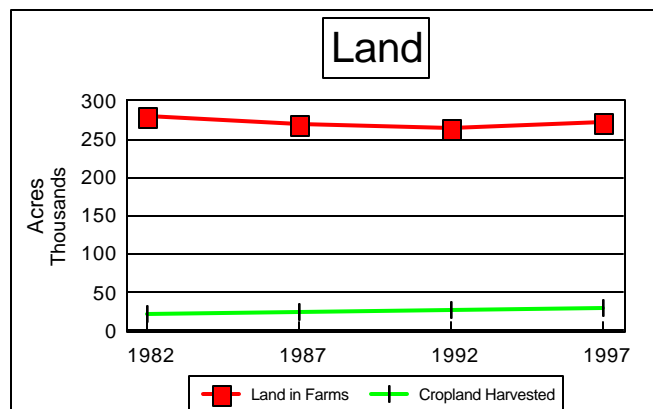
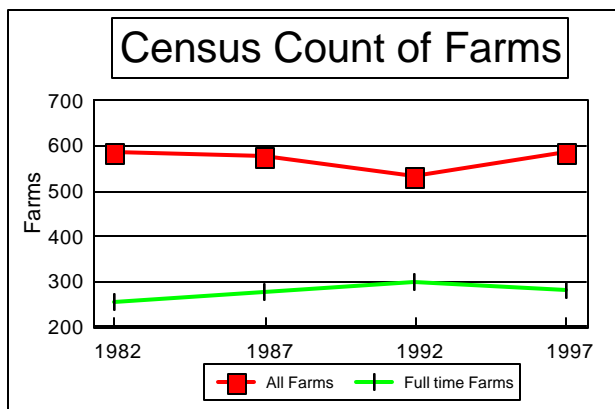
Increased 34 percent to \$17,859,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 4 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 96 percent of the market value.
