Market value of agricultural products sold

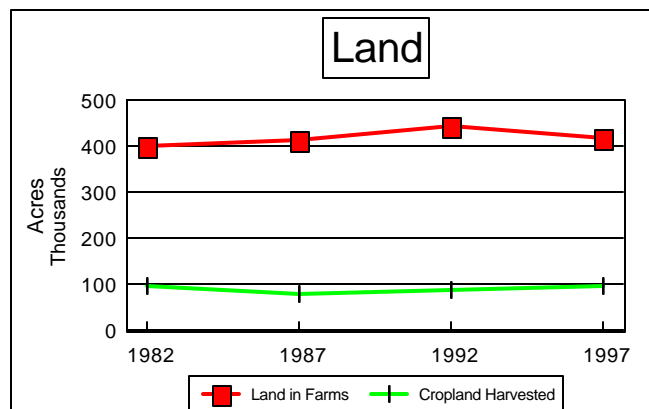
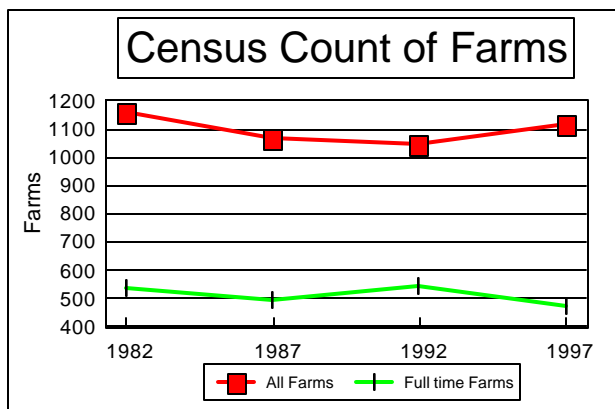
Increased 14 percent to \$61,663,000 in 1997.
