Land in farms

Increased 4 percent from 336,285 acres in 1992 to 351,400 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 20 percent from 299 acres in 1992 to 238 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 24 percent from 365 farms in 1992 to 452 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

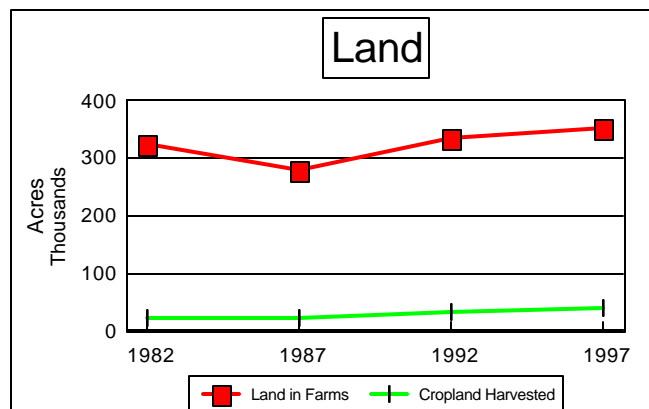
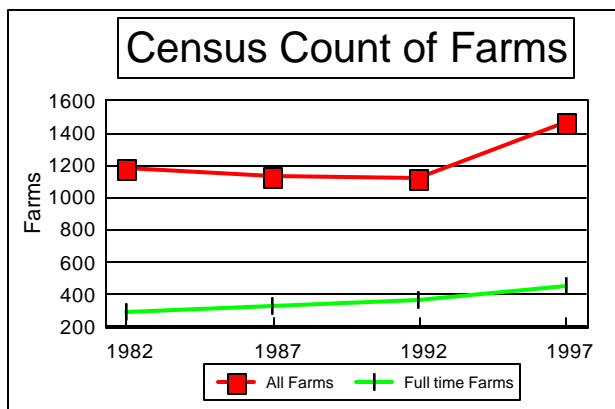
Increased 18 percent to \$14,592,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 15 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 85 percent of the market value.
