Average size of farms

Increased 3 percent from 843 acres in 1992 to 869 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 9 percent from 425 farms in 1992 to 386 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

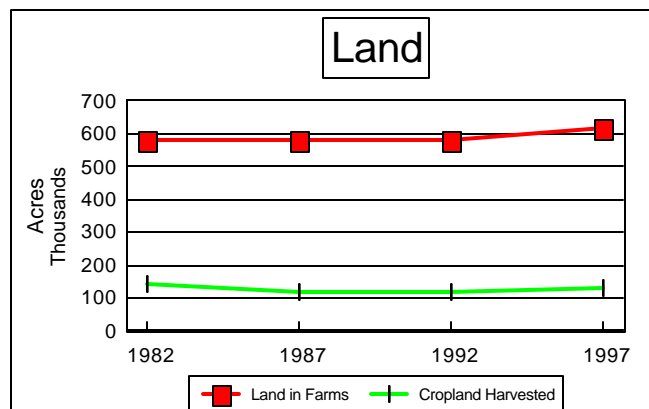
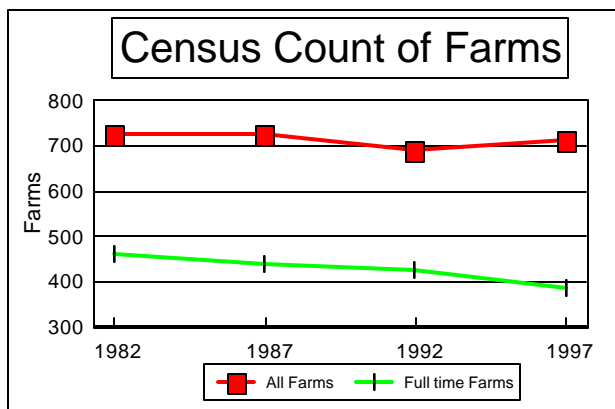
Decreased 3 percent to \$34,260,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.
