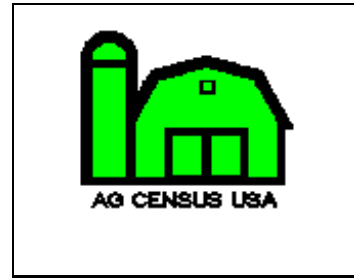

Land in farms

Decreased 7 percent from 662,121 acres in 1992 to 614,690 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Unchanged from 575 acres in 1992 to 575 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 16 percent from 700 farms in 1992 to 589 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

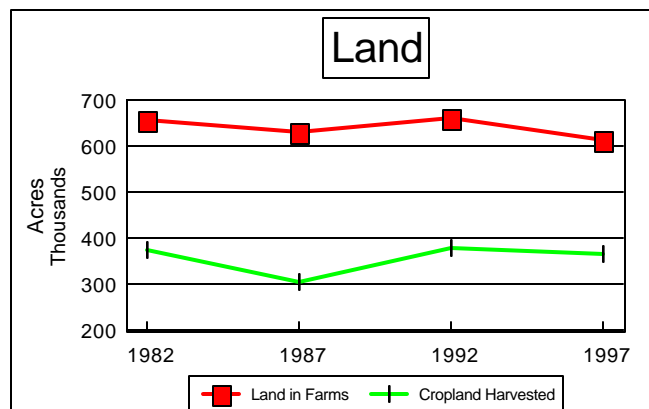
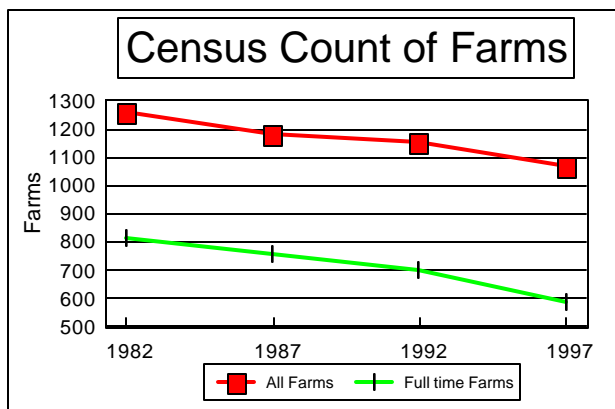
Increased 8 percent to \$82,977,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 47 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 53 percent of the market value.
