Land in farms

Increased 7 percent from 419,760 acres in 1992 to 448,693 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 1 percent from 321 acres in 1992 to 325 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 3 percent from 609 farms in 1992 to 627 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

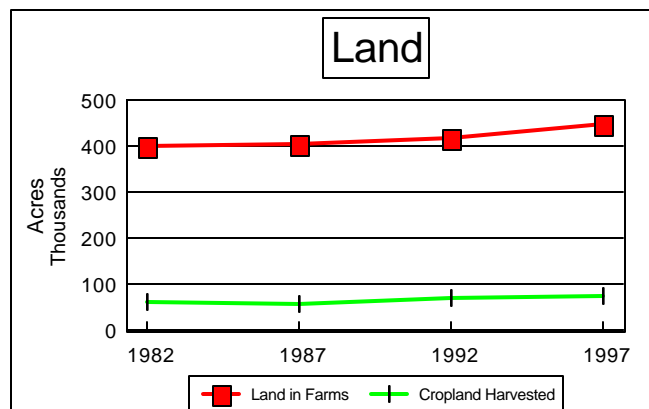
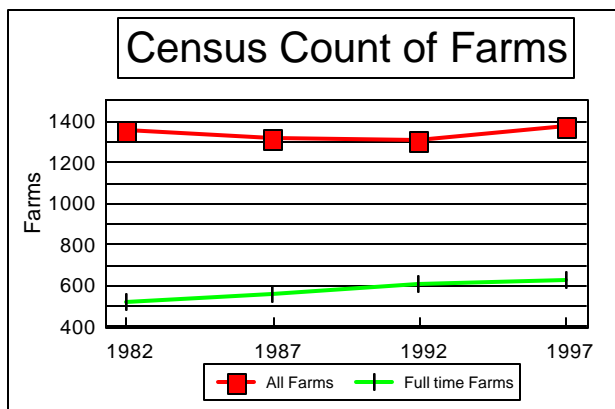
Increased 6 percent to \$34,245,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 25 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 75 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased slightly from \$24,699 in 1992 to \$24,815 in 1997.
