Increased 8 percent from 566,152 acres in 1992 to 608,870 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 5 percent from 395 acres in 1992 to 375 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 1 percent from 748 farms in 1992 to 758 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

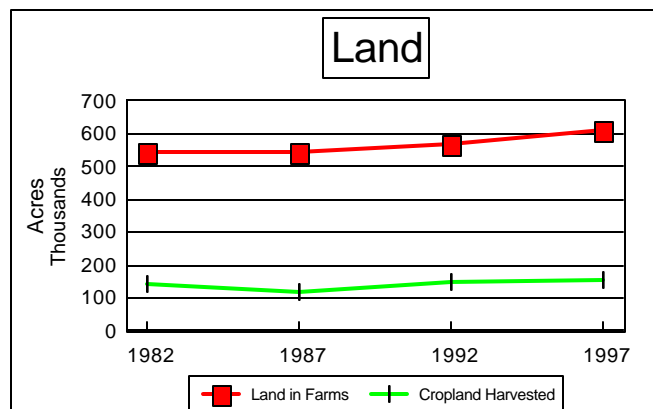
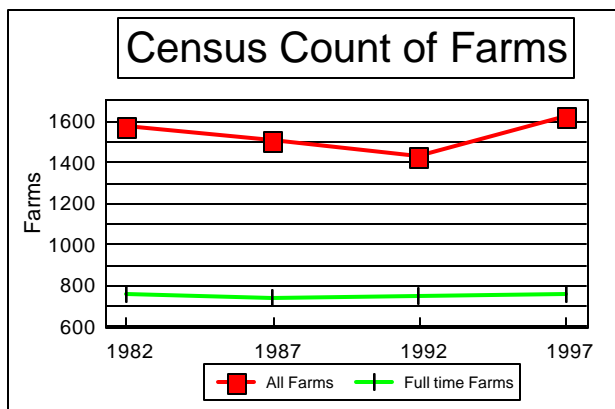
Increased 13 percent to \$89,271,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 16 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 84 percent of the market value.
