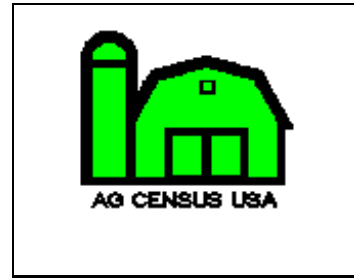


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## GRANT OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Decreased 2 percent from 599,536 acres in 1992 to 584,588 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 8 percent from 785 acres in 1992 to 850 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 16 percent from 521 farms in 1992 to 439 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

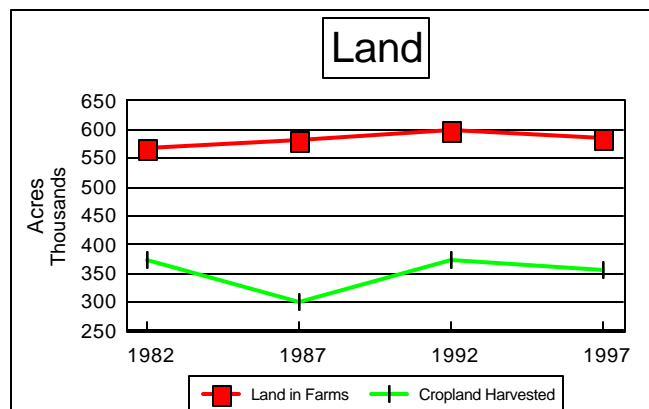
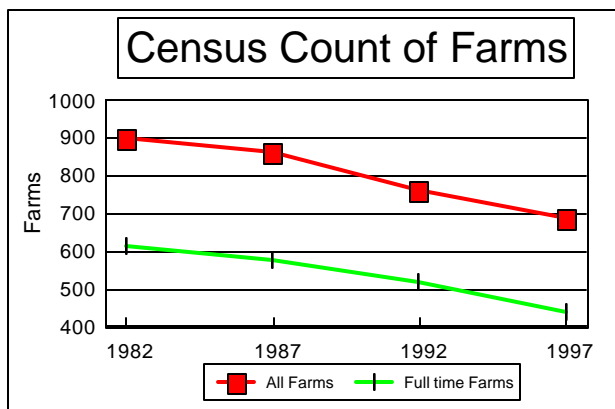
Increased 13 percent to \$61,155,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 64 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 36 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 25 percent from \$71,082 in 1992 to \$88,888 in 1997.
