Land in farms

Increased 6 percent from 286,379 acres in 1992 to 304,189 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 4 percent from 863 acres in 1992 to 900 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 12 percent from 212 farms in 1992 to 186 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

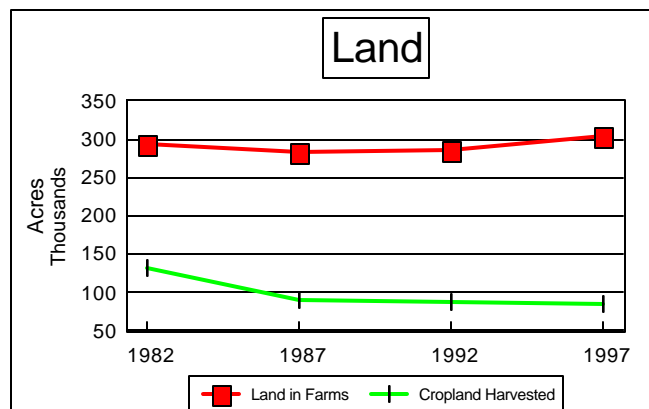
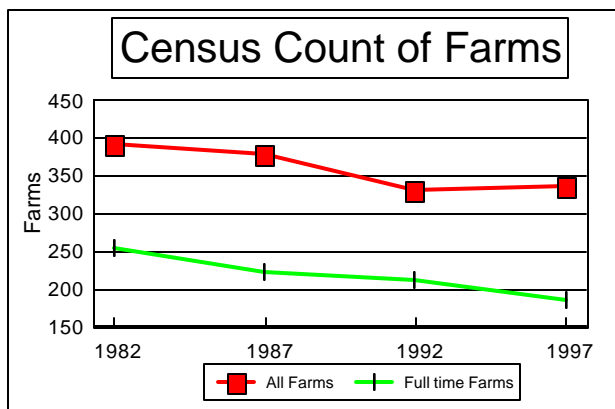
Increased 9 percent to \$21,738,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 56 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 44 percent of the market value.
