Decreased slightly from 268,038 acres in 1992 to 267,655 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 13 percent from 351 acres in 1992 to 307 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 12 percent from 364 farms in 1992 to 406 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

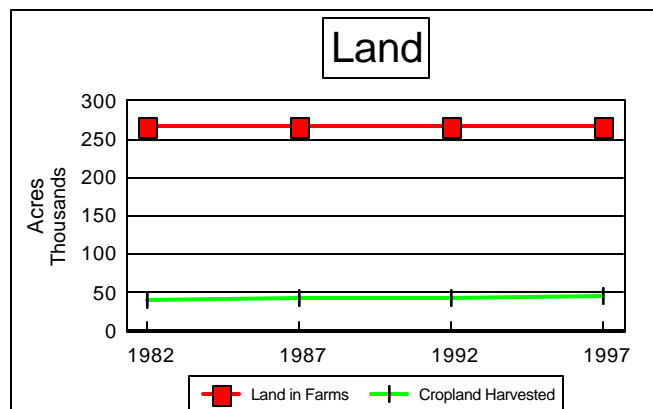
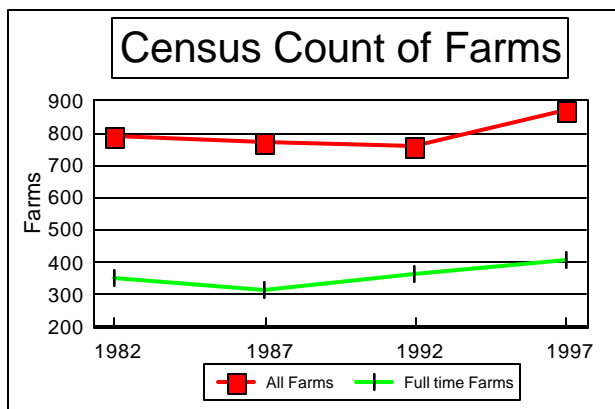
Increased 86 percent to \$33,304,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 97 percent of the market value.
