## HUGHES OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 2 percent from 346,572 acres in 1992 to 355,192 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 12 percent from 449 acres in 1992 to 396 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 17 percent from 337 farms in 1992 to 395 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

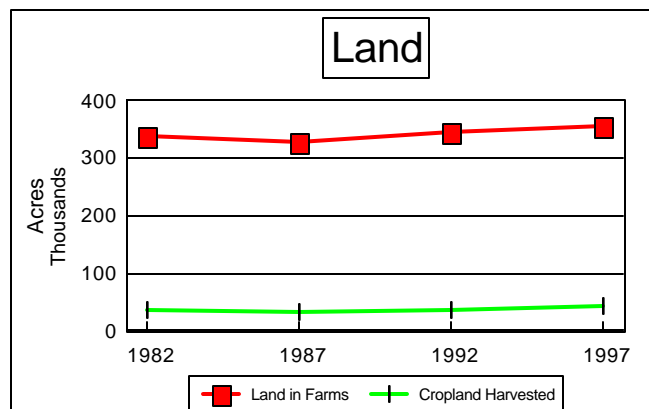
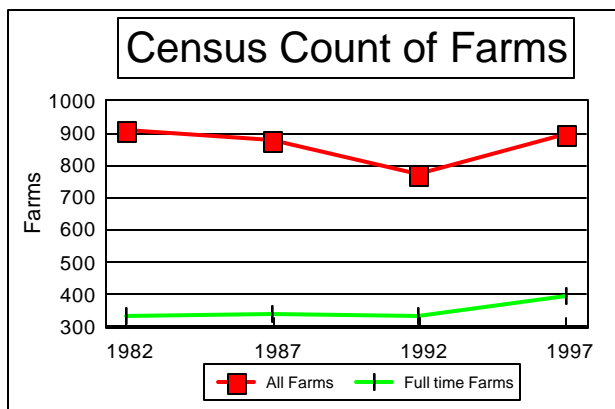
Increased 159 percent to \$40,524,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 10 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 90 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 123 percent from \$20,285 in 1992 to \$45,177 in 1997.
