Market value of agricultural products sold

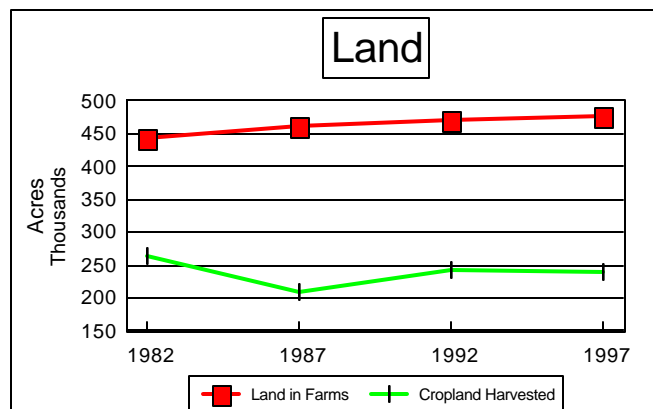
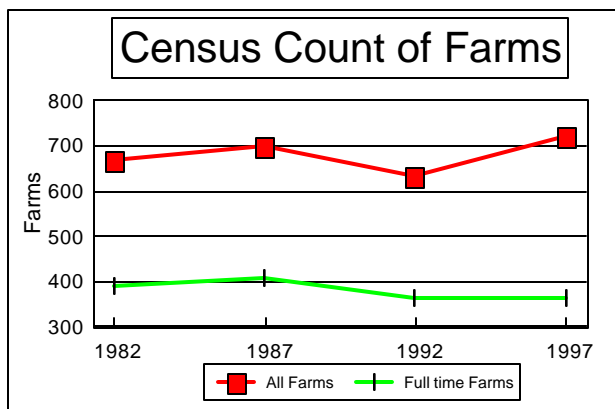
Increased 37 percent to \$68,685,000 in 1997.
