### Land in farms

Decreased 2 percent from 477,655 acres in 1992 to 469,493 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 2 percent from 495 acres in 1992 to 505 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 553 farms in 1992 to 518 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

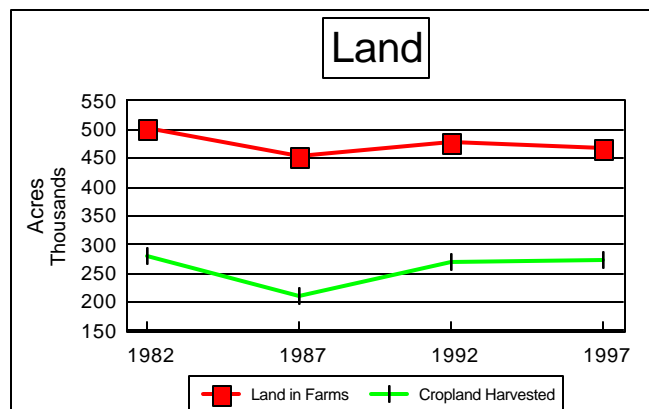
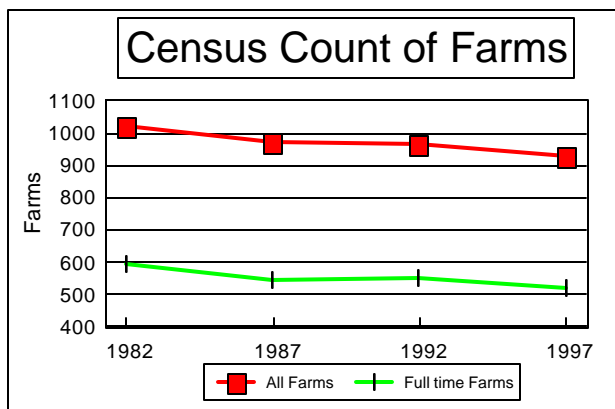
Increased 20 percent to \$56,486,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 66 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 34 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 25 percent from \$48,628 in 1992 to \$60,803 in 1997.
