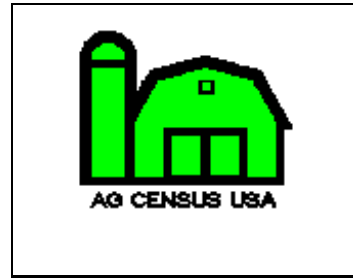


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## KINGFISHER OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 6 percent from 521,820 acres in 1992 to 554,988 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 567 acres in 1992 to 556 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased slightly from 546 farms in 1992 to 550 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

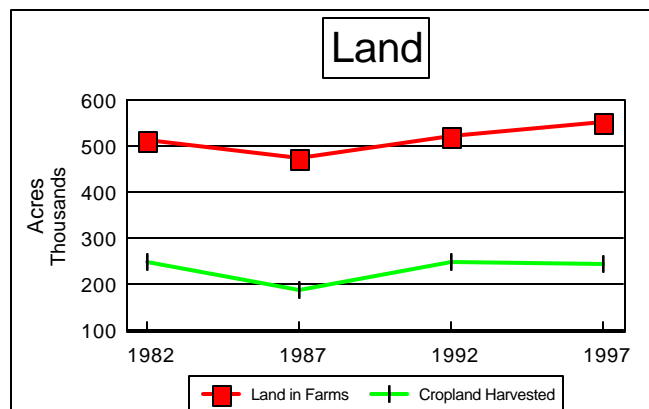
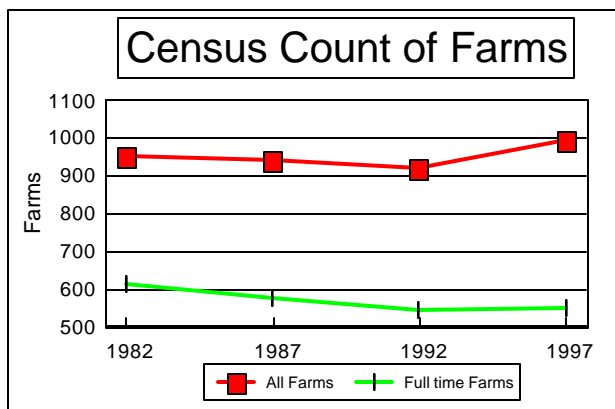
Increased 31 percent to \$99,470,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 21 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 79 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 21 percent from \$82,693 in 1992 to \$99,669 in 1997.
