Increased 7 percent from 558,313 acres in 1992 to 595,283 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 5 percent from 807 acres in 1992 to 848 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 13 percent from 467 farms in 1992 to 406 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

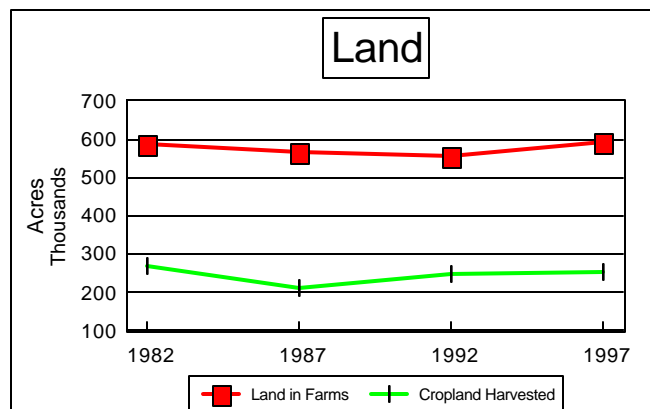
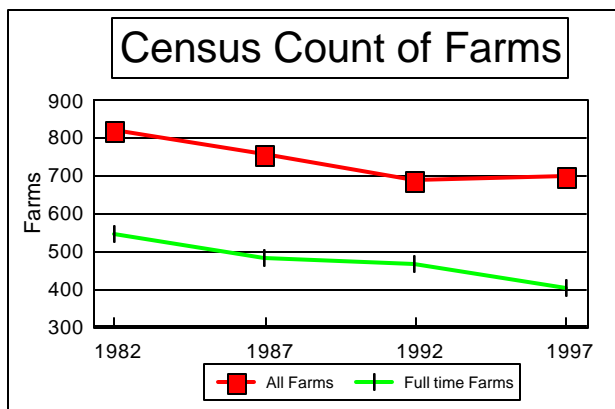
Increased 13 percent to \$51,826,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 37 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 63 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 11 percent from \$66,282 in 1992 to \$73,826 in 1997.
