Decreased 6 percent from 240 acres in 1992 to 225 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 4 percent from 650 farms in 1992 to 678 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

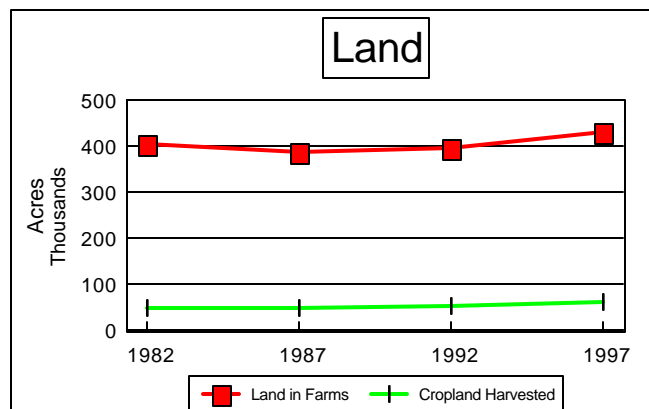
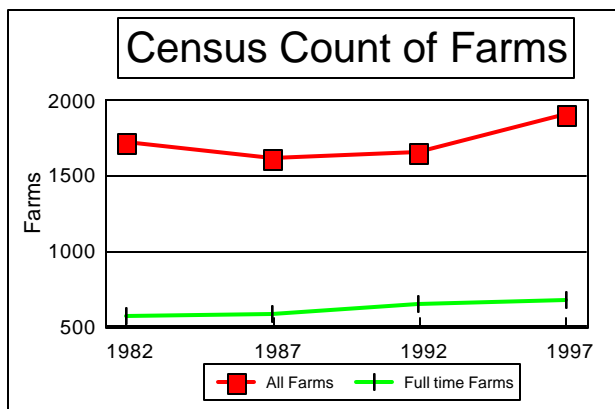
Increased 14 percent to \$23,511,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 13 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 87 percent of the market value.
