## LOGAN OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 11 percent from 344,280 acres in 1992 to 380,529 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 1 percent from 392 acres in 1992 to 387 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 1 percent from 410 farms in 1992 to 415 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

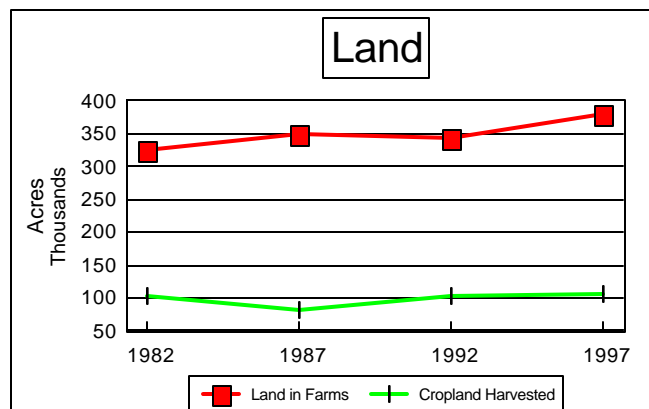
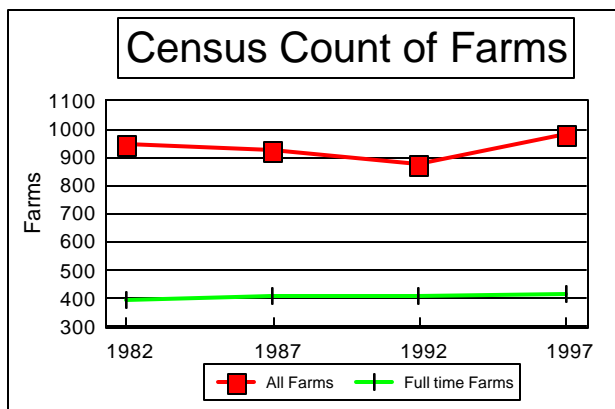
Increased 9 percent to \$39,403,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 27 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 73 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 3 percent from \$41,143 in 1992 to \$40,084 in 1997.
