Land in farms

Increased slightly from 162,690 acres in 1992 to 163,584 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 15 percent from 466 acres in 1992 to 395 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 6 percent from 156 farms in 1992 to 165 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

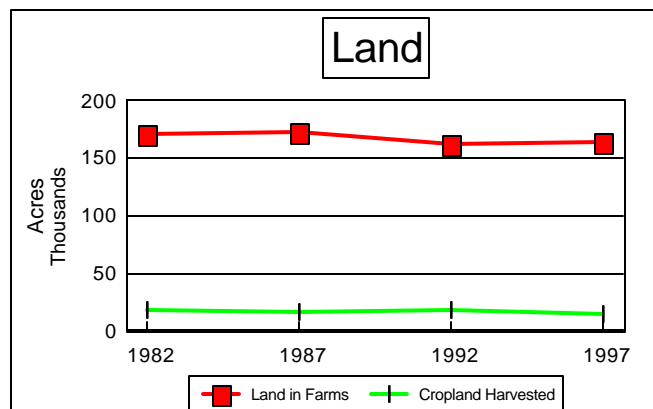
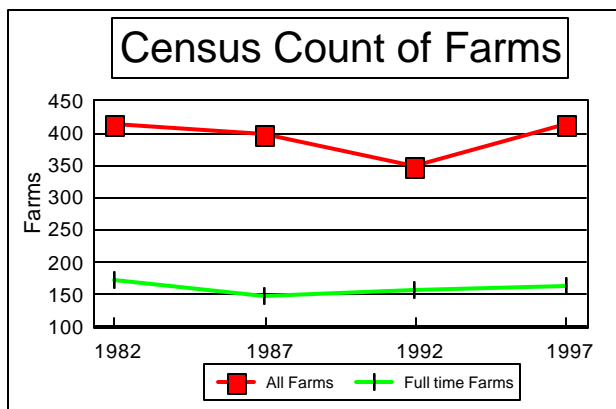
Decreased 36 percent to \$6,076,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 19 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 81 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 46 percent from \$27,308 in 1992 to \$14,677 in 1997.
