Land in farms

Increased 6 percent from 253,652 acres in 1992 to 268,034 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 14 percent from 298 acres in 1992 to 256 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 5 percent from 390 farms in 1992 to 409 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

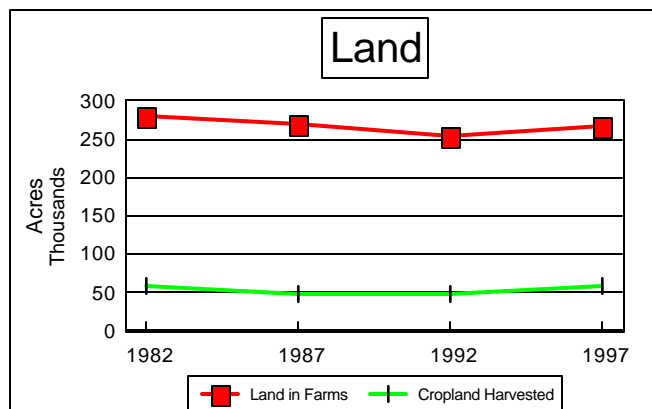
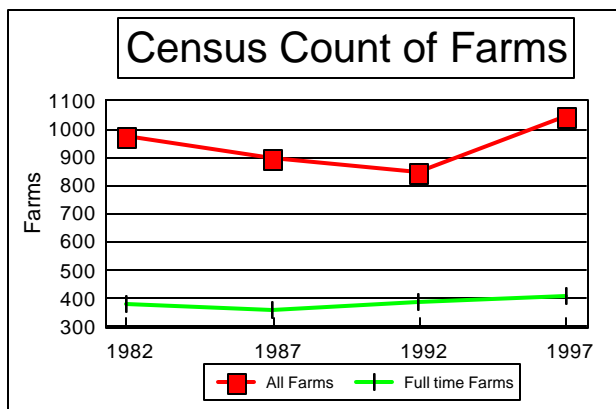
Decreased slightly

Livestock sales accounted for 78 percent of the market value.
