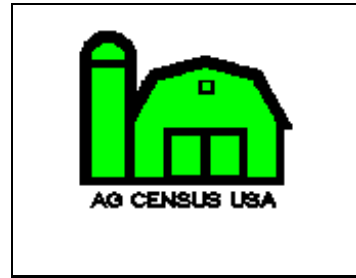

MCCURTAIN OKLAHOMA

Land in farms

Increased 4 percent from 314,987 acres in 1992 to 327,524 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 13 percent from 240 acres in 1992 to 208 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 9 percent from 614 farms in 1992 to 672 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

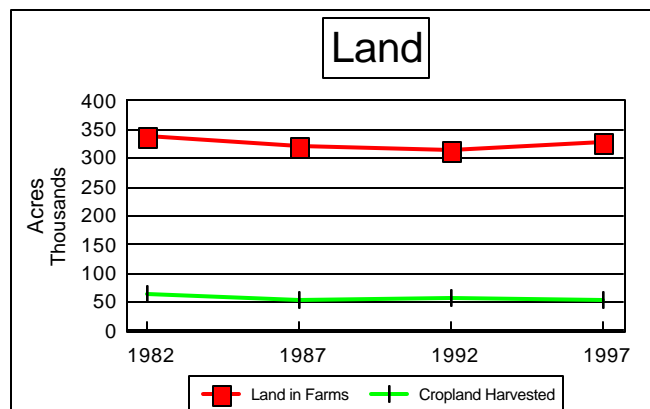
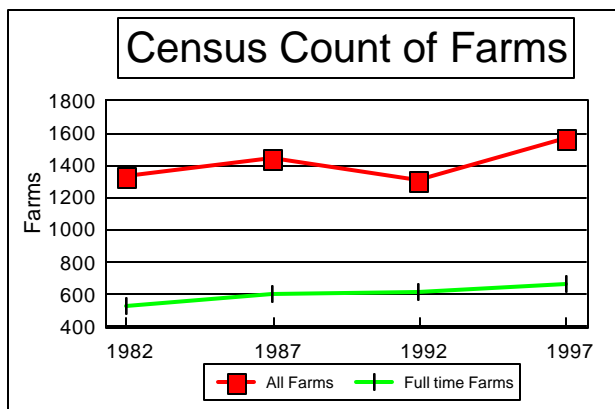
Increased 50 percent to \$137,081,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 3 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 97 percent of the market value.
