Increased 7 percent from 236,766 acres in 1992 to 253,667 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 5 percent from 294 acres in 1992 to 280 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 7 percent from 380 farms in 1992 to 406 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

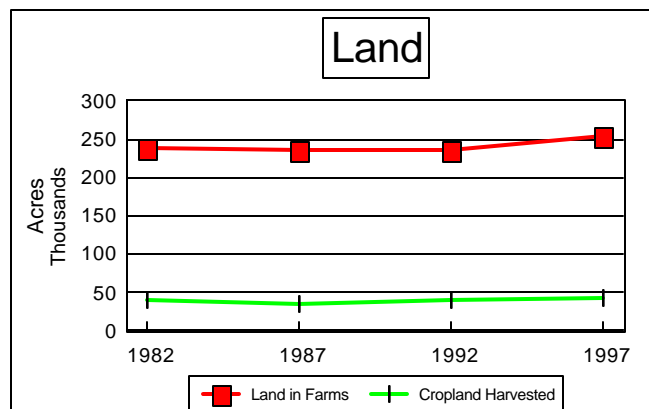
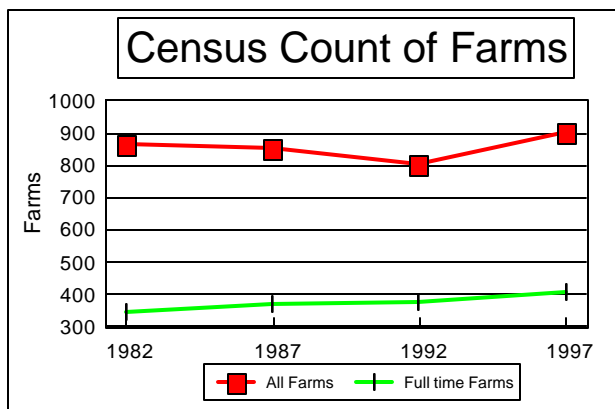
Increased 25 percent to \$15,887,000 in 1997.
