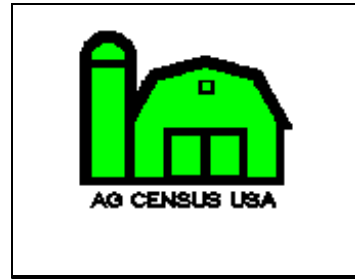

MURRAY OKLAHOMA

Land in farms

Decreased 12 percent from 230,832 acres in 1992 to 203,486 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 20 percent from 562 acres in 1992 to 448 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 10 percent from 210 farms in 1992 to 189 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

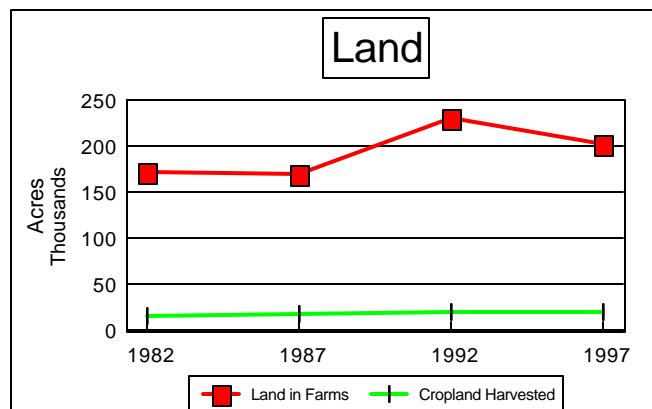
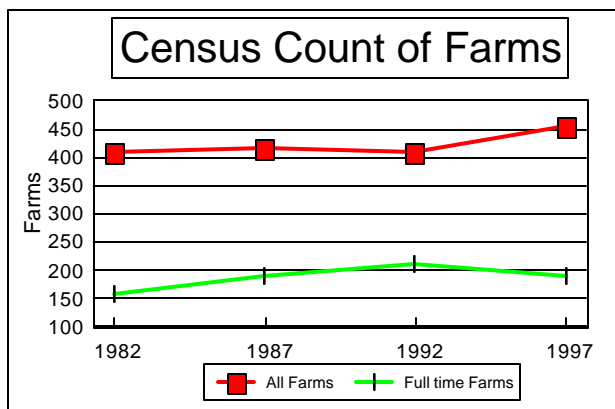
Increased 7 percent to \$20,459,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 3 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 97 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 3 percent from \$46,522 in 1992 to \$45,064 in 1997.
