Decreased 4 percent from 347,480 acres in 1992 to 332,566 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 17 percent from 275 acres in 1992 to 227 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 11 percent from 538 farms in 1992 to 599 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

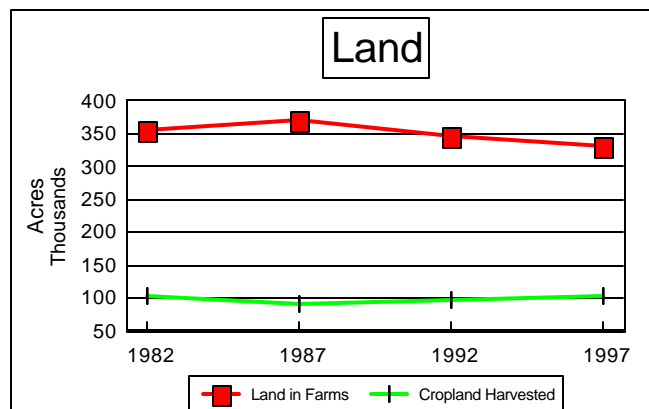
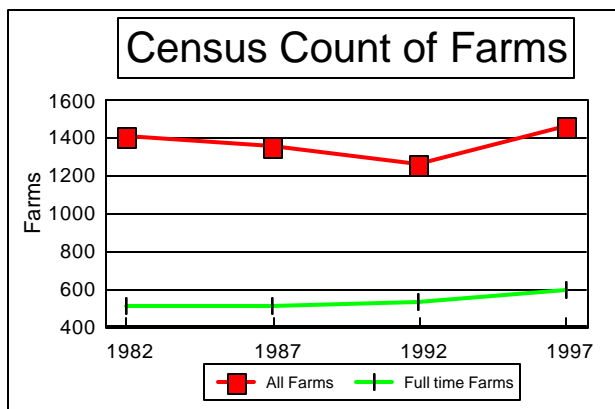
Decreased 15 percent to \$31,658,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 40 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 60 percent of the market value.
