## OKMULGEE OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 8 percent from 280,533 acres in 1992 to 302,155 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 9 percent from 301 acres in 1992 to 273 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 38 percent from 328 farms in 1992 to 451 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

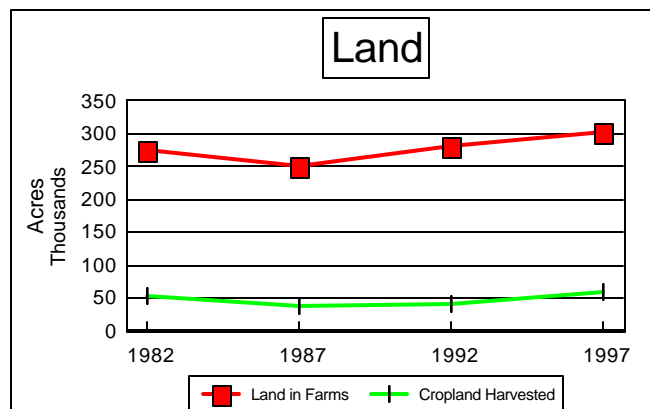
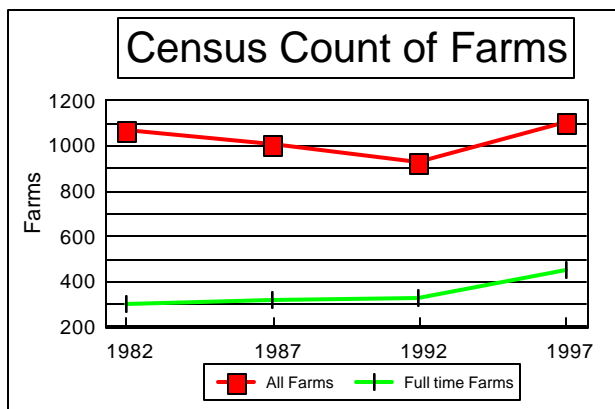
Increased 15 percent to \$18,819,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 22 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 78 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 3 percent from \$17,571 in 1992 to \$17,000 in 1997.
