## OSAGE OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 8 percent from 1,116,090 acres in 1992 to 1,207,462 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 4 percent from 1,048 acres in 1992 to 1,010 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 4 percent from 492 farms in 1992 to 510 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

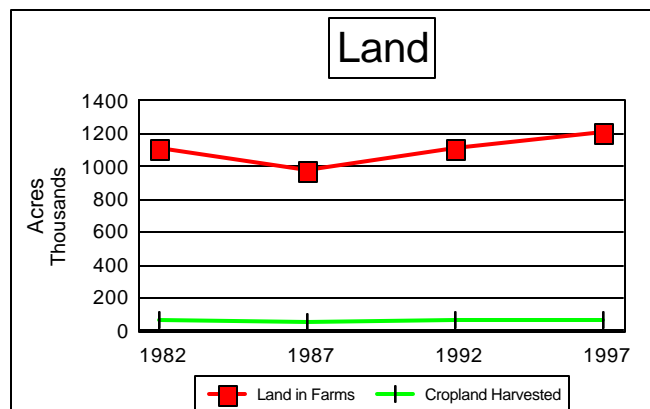
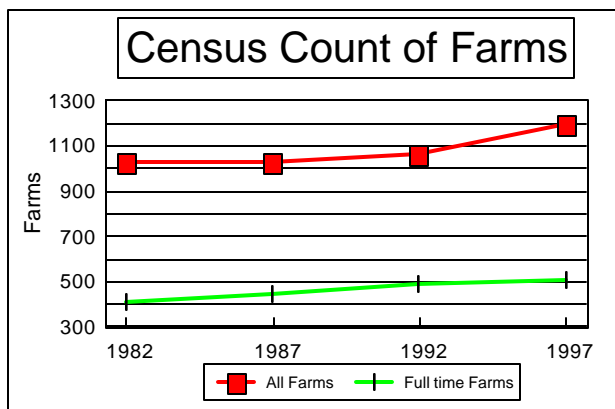
Increased 25 percent to \$102,882,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 5 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 95 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 11 percent from \$77,527 in 1992 to \$86,022 in 1997.
