### Land in farms

Increased 4 percent from 207,118 acres in 1992 to 214,870 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 4 percent from 231 acres in 1992 to 221 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 9 percent from 424 farms in 1992 to 387 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

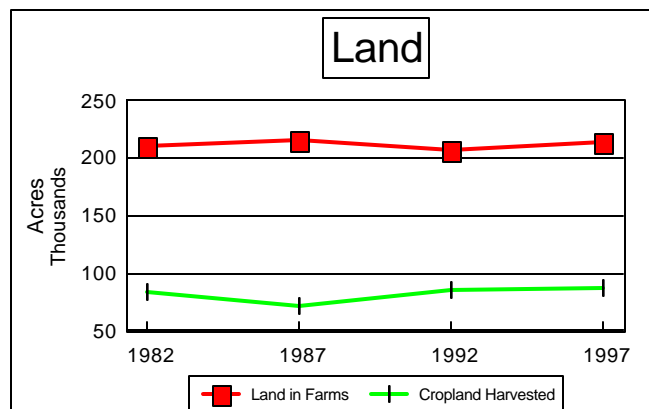
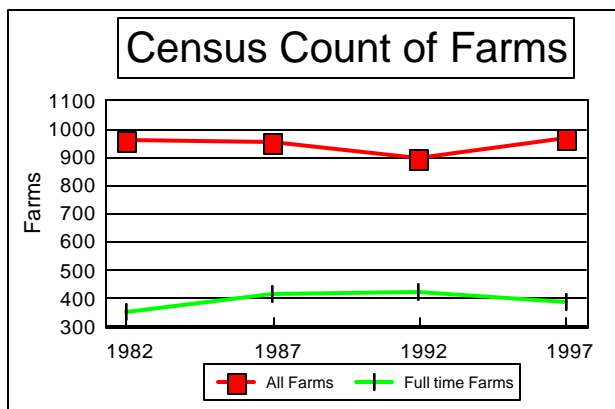
Increased 25 percent to \$52,773,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 53 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 47 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 15 percent from \$47,146 in 1992 to \$54,294 in 1997.
