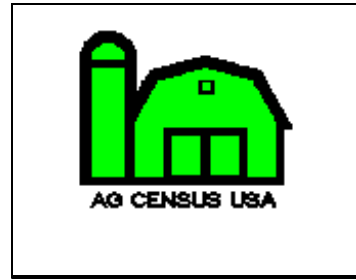

PAWNEE OKLAHOMA

Land in farms

Decreased 7 percent from 282,211 acres in 1992 to 263,369 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 12 percent from 447 acres in 1992 to 393 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased slightly from 283 farms in 1992 to 282 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

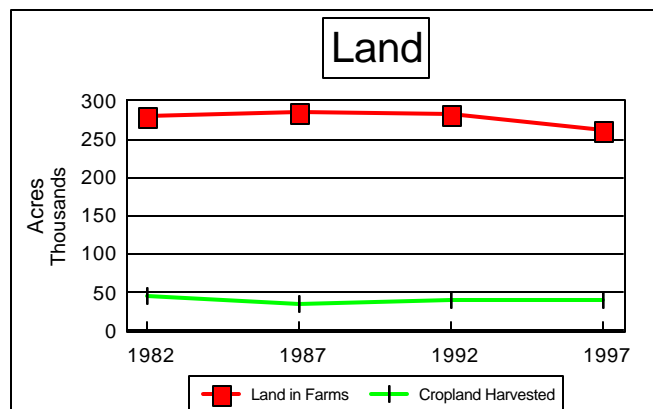
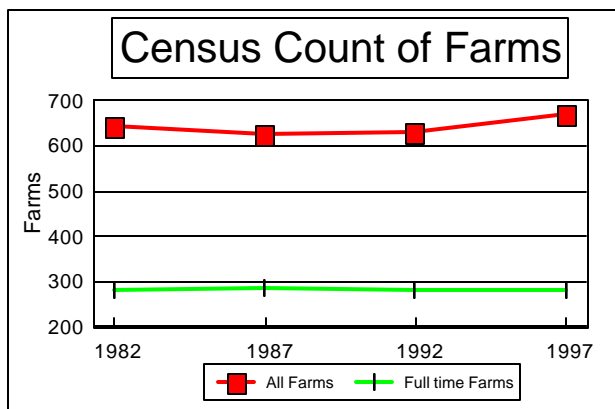
Decreased 49 percent to \$17,876,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 20 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 80 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 52 percent from \$55,416 in 1992 to \$26,640 in 1997.
