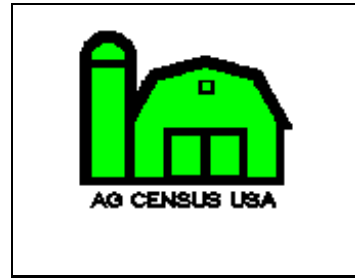

BLAINE OKLAHOMA

Land in farms

Increased 6 percent from 513,789 acres in 1992 to 546,677 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 4 percent from 623 acres in 1992 to 650 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 15 percent from 522 farms in 1992 to 442 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

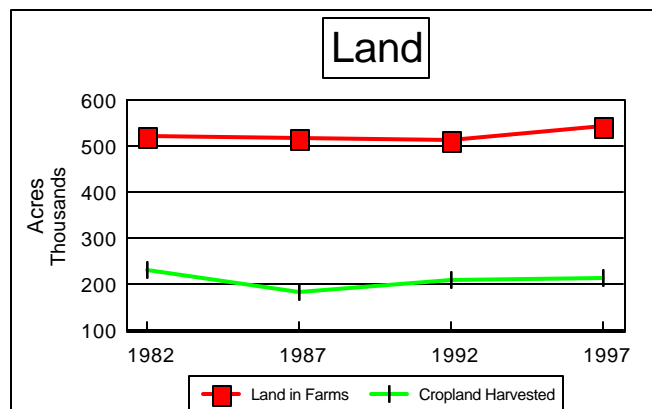
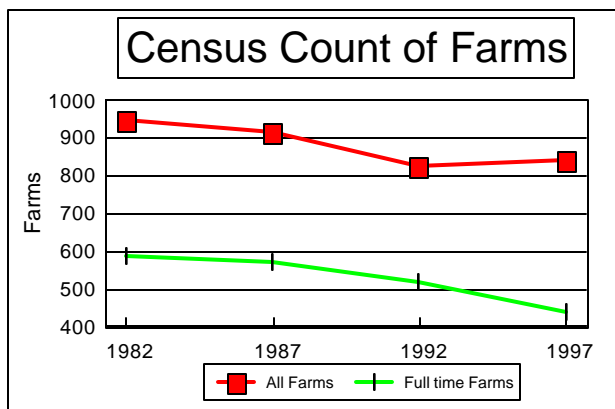
Increased 9 percent to \$77,367,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 23 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 77 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 7 percent from \$86,221 in 1992 to \$91,994 in 1997.
