Land in farms

Increased 3 percent from 328,976 acres in 1992 to 339,359 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 10 percent from 295 acres in 1992 to 265 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 5 percent from 460 farms in 1992 to 437 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

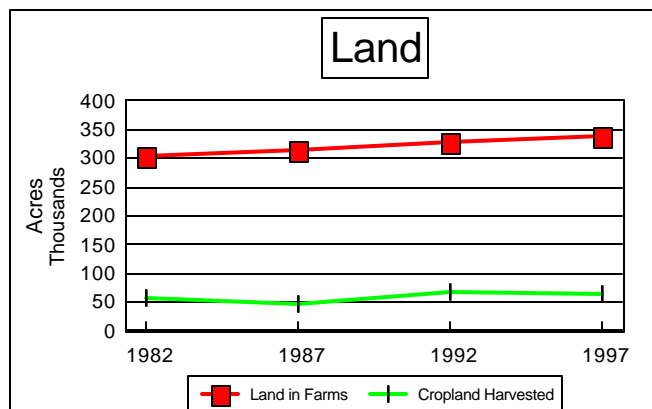
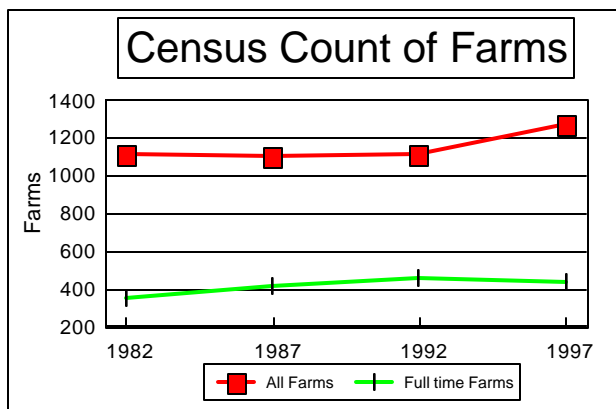
Decreased 16 percent to \$22,375,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 17 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 83 percent of the market value.
