Increased 11 percent from 514 farms in 1992 to 569 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

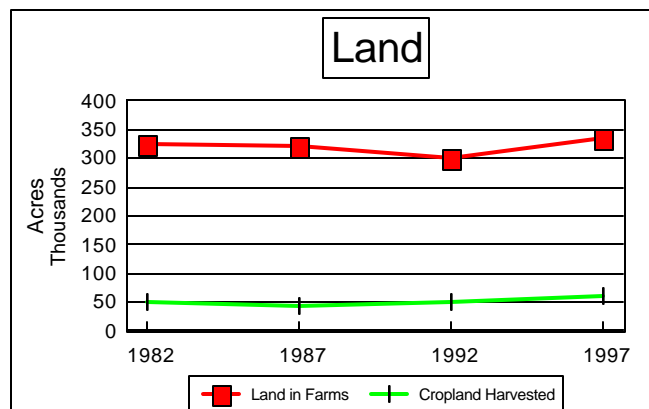
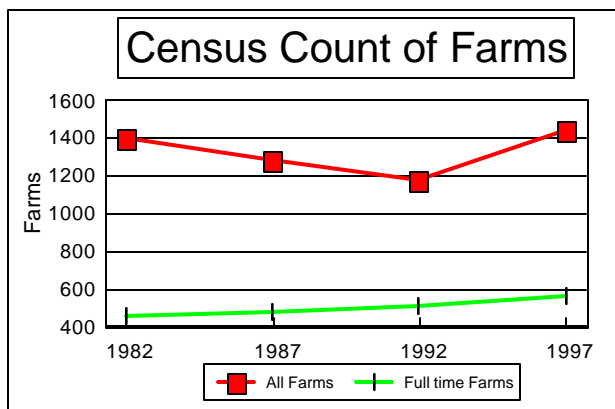
Increased 109 percent to \$32,999,000 in 1997.
