## PUSHMATAHA OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 7 percent from 239,971 acres in 1992 to 256,438 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 11 percent from 371 acres in 1992 to 330 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 7 percent from 318 farms in 1992 to 340 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

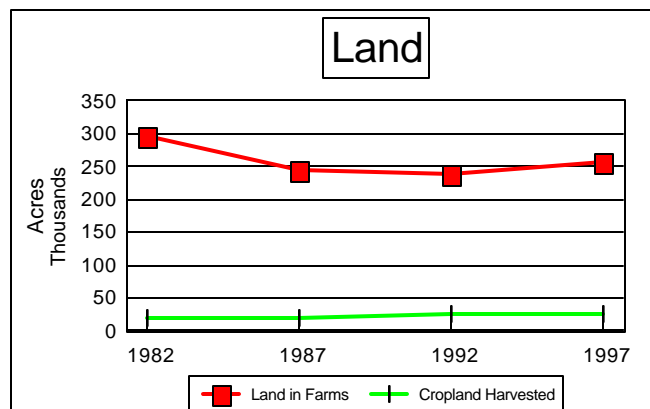
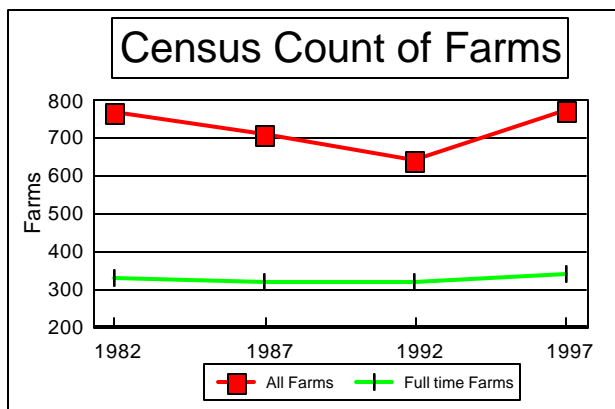
Decreased 25 percent to \$7,704,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 5 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 95 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 37 percent from \$15,813 in 1992 to \$9,928 in 1997.
