Decreased 4 percent from 422 farms in 1992 to 404 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

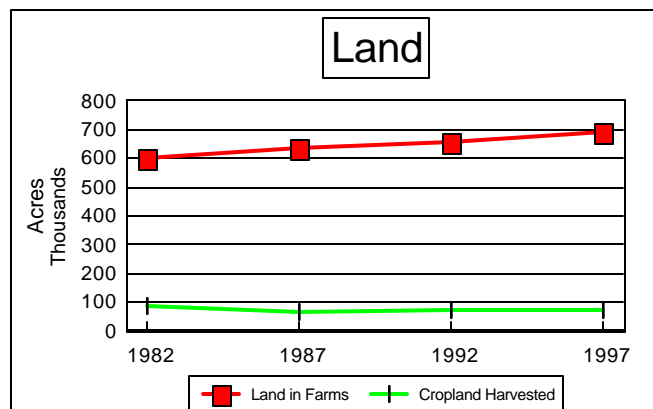
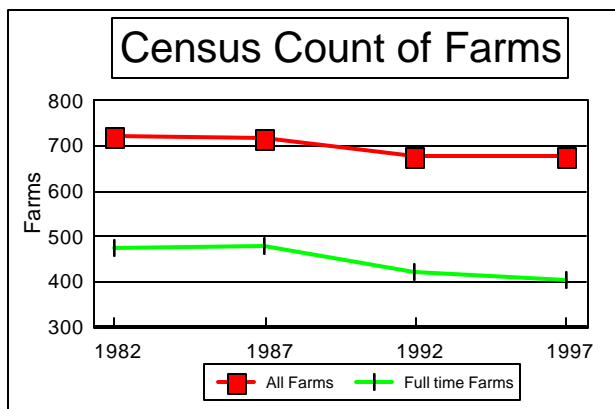
Decreased 4 percent to \$27,511,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 83 percent of the market value.
