Increased 1 percent from 309,614 acres in 1992 to 312,870 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 10 percent from 246 acres in 1992 to 222 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 6 percent from 462 farms in 1992 to 492 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

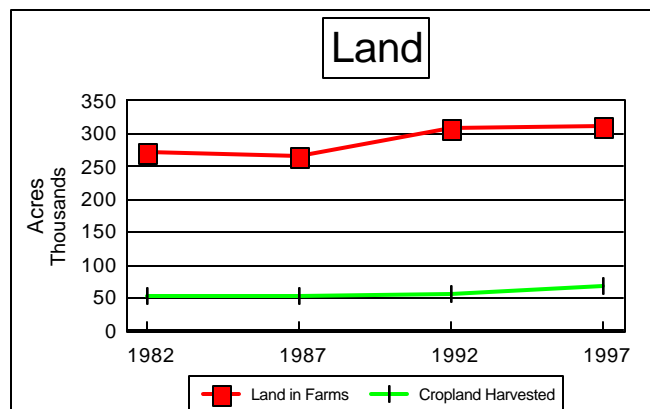
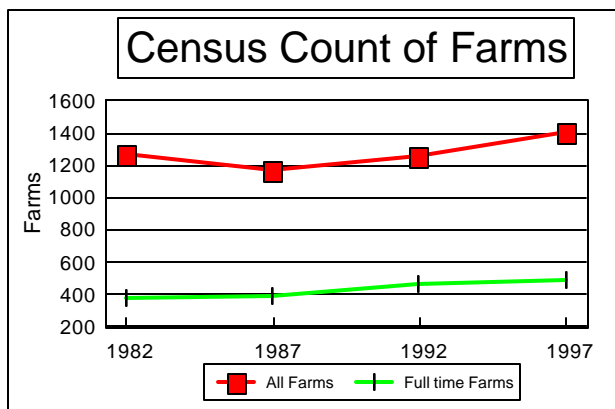
Increased 18 percent to \$27,129,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 78 percent of the market value.
