Land in farms

Increased 11 percent from 250,958 acres in 1992 to 277,535 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 5 percent from 288 acres in 1992 to 273 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 6 percent from 343 farms in 1992 to 365 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

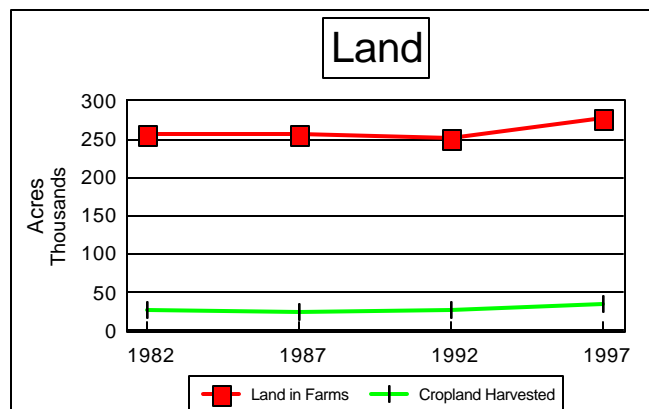
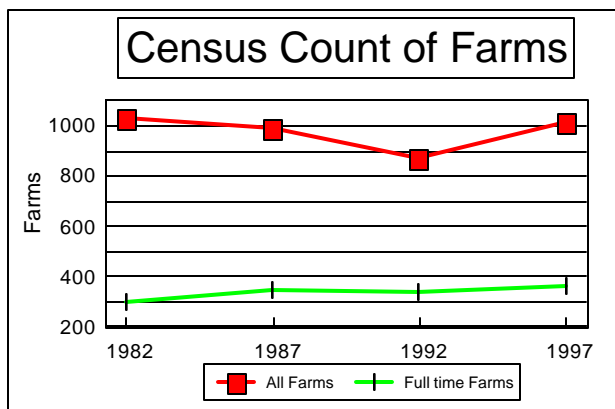
Increased 49 percent to \$14,427,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 16 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 84 percent of the market value.
