## SEQUOYAH OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 36 percent from 215,222 acres in 1992 to 293,366 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 11 percent from 236 acres in 1992 to 261 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 19 percent from 346 farms in 1992 to 411 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

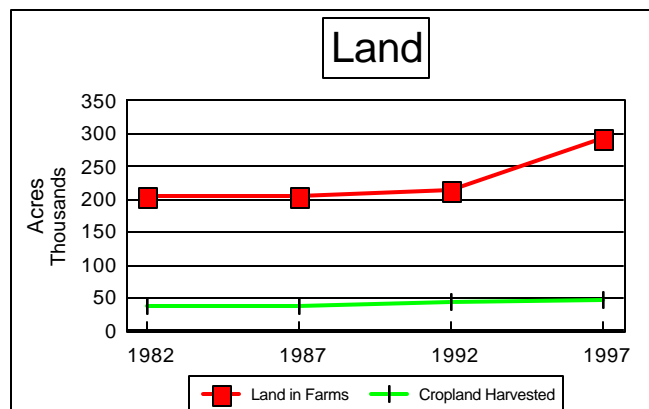
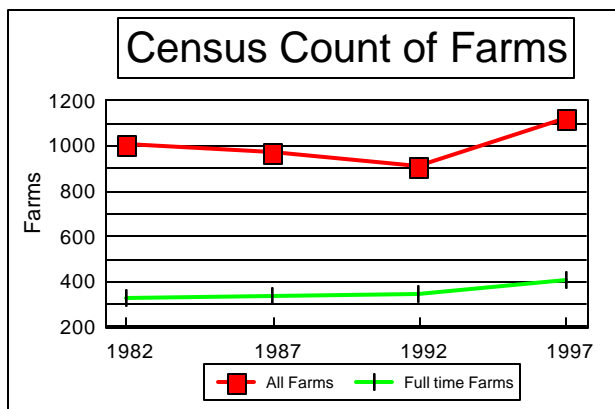
Increased 242 percent to \$39,105,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 12 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 88 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 178 percent from \$12,510 in 1992 to \$34,760 in 1997.
