## TEXAS OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 3 percent from 1,051,384 acres in 1992 to 1,086,667 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 7 percent from 1,493 acres in 1992 to 1,384 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 462 farms in 1992 to 436 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

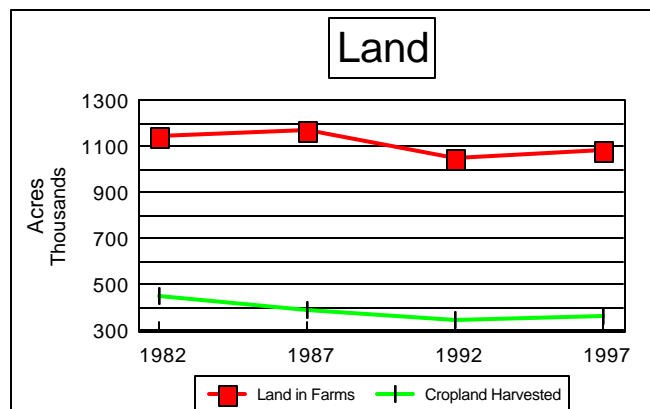
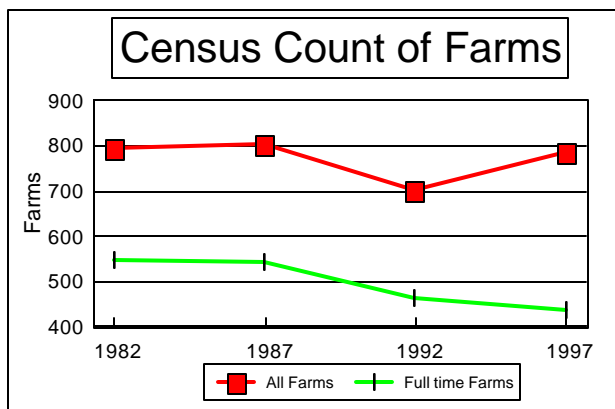
Increased 32 percent to \$668,024,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 8 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 92 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 19 percent from \$716,335 in 1992 to \$850,985 in 1997.
