Average size of farms

Decreased 11 percent from 819 acres in 1992 to 730 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 392 farms in 1992 to 367 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

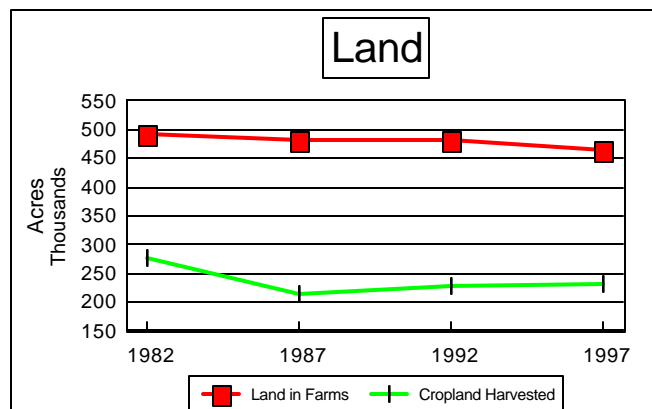
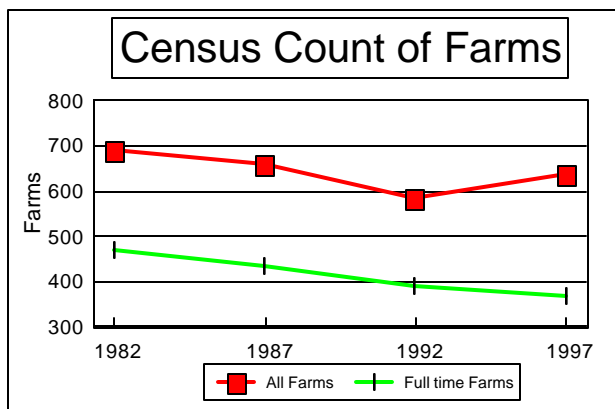
Increased 2 percent to \$41,124,000 in 1997.
