Increased 16 percent from 247 farms in 1992 to 287 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

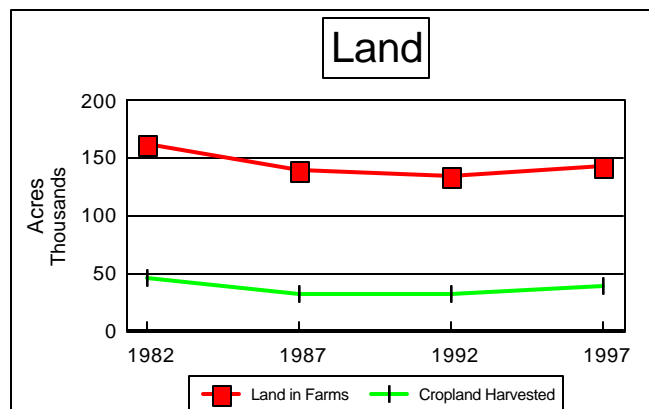
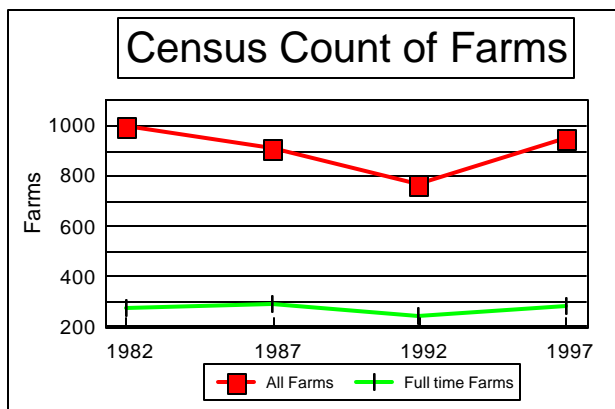
Increased 45 percent to \$19,725,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 34 percent of the market value.
