Increased 11 percent from 216,638 acres in 1992 to 240,660 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 6 percent from 263 acres in 1992 to 247 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 6 percent from 334 farms in 1992 to 353 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

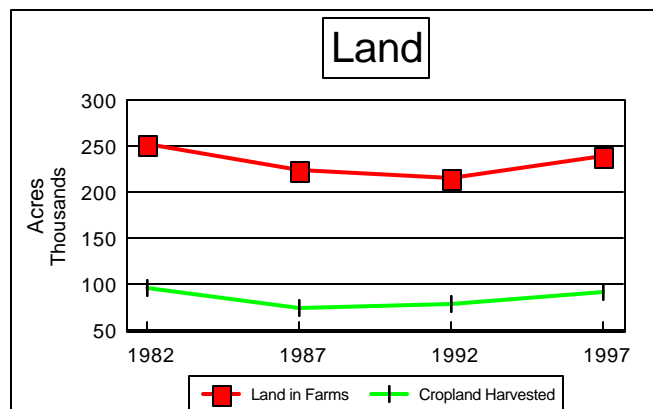
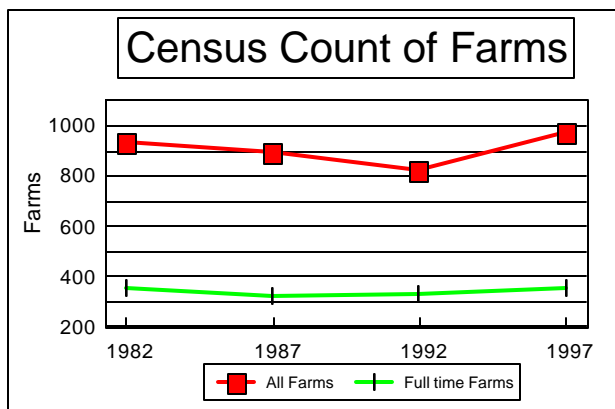
Increased 45 percent to \$28,856,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 36 percent of the market value.
