## WOODS OKLAHOMA

### Land in farms

Increased 8 percent from 743,563 acres in 1992 to 804,637 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 4 percent from 1,098 acres in 1992 to 1,141 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 436 farms in 1992 to 427 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

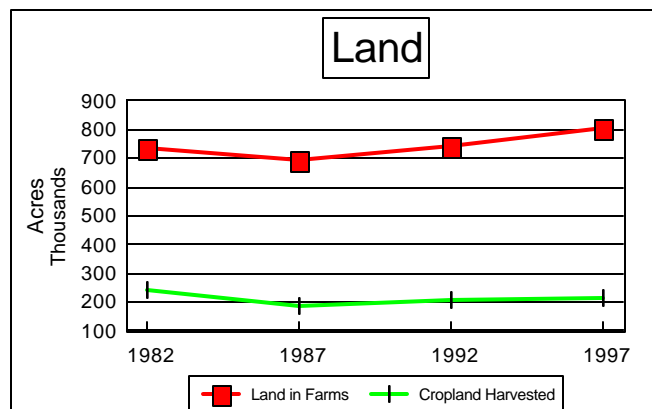
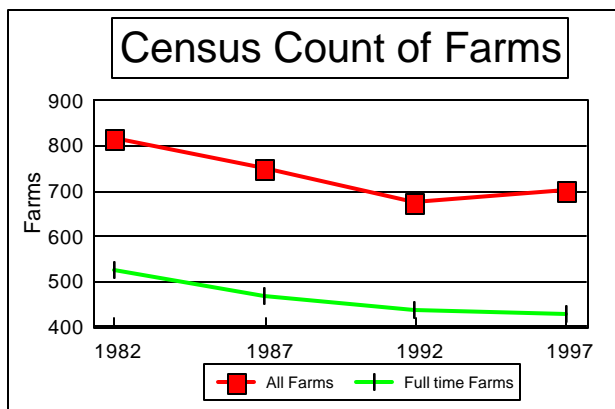
Increased 19 percent to \$81,400,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 27 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 73 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 15 percent from \$100,621 in 1992 to \$115,461 in 1997.
