Unchanged from 405 farms in 1992 to 405 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

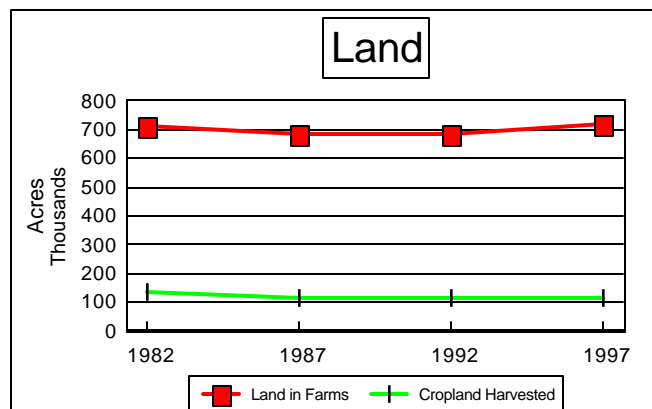
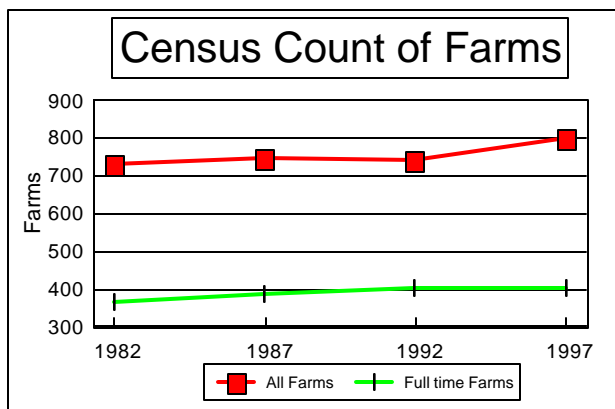
Increased 49 percent to \$49,697,000 in 1997.
