Decreased 14 percent from 467 acres in 1992 to 401 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 5 percent from 612 farms in 1992 to 583 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

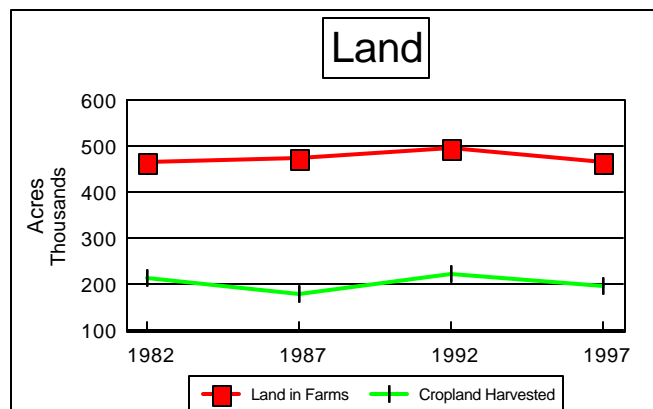
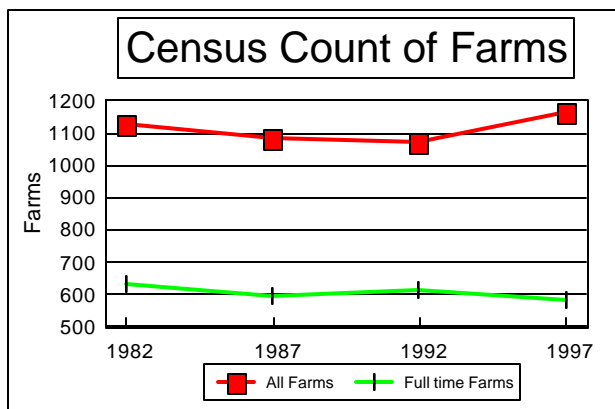
Decreased 7 percent to \$66,587,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 29 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 71 percent of the market value.
