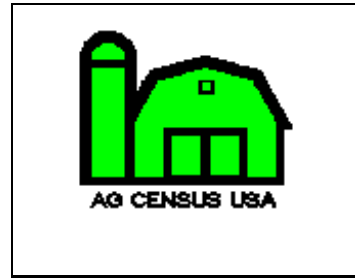

Land in farms

Decreased 10 percent from 39,559 acres in 1992 to 35,580 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 3 percent from 117 acres in 1992 to 114 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 22 percent from 256 farms in 1992 to 200 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

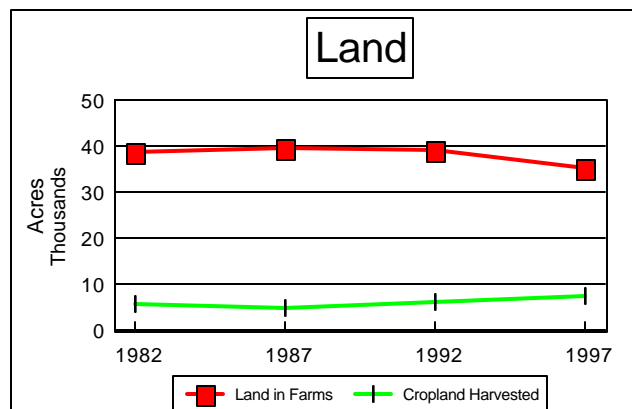
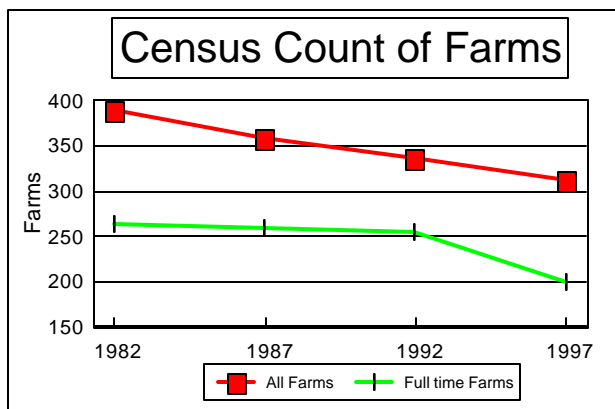
Decreased 2 percent to \$62,504,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 1 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 99 percent of the market value.
