## WARREN PENNSYLVANIA

### Land in farms

Decreased 4 percent from 67,388 acres in 1992 to 64,498 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 6 percent from 175 acres in 1992 to 165 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased slightly from 192 farms in 1992 to 191 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

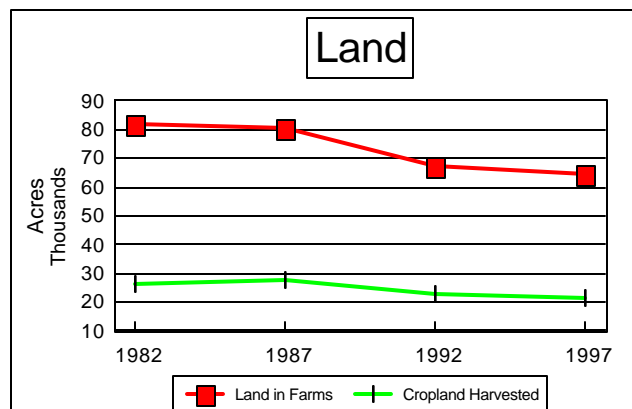
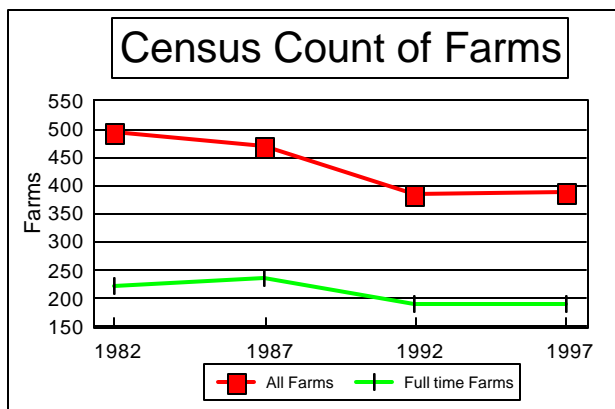
Decreased 3 percent to \$14,631,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 14 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 86 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 4 percent from \$39,018 in 1992 to \$37,516 in 1997.
