Decreased 7 percent from 2,298 acres in 1992 to 2,132 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 13 percent from 371 farms in 1992 to 324 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

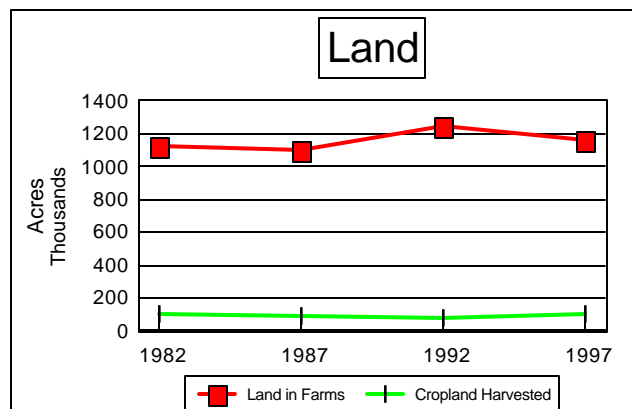
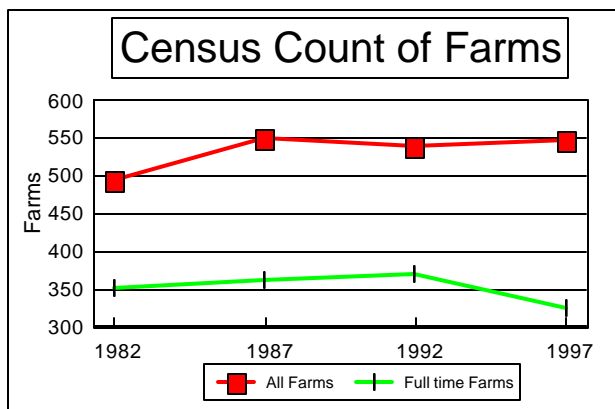
Increased 4 percent to \$41,119,000 in 1997.
