Market value of agricultural products sold

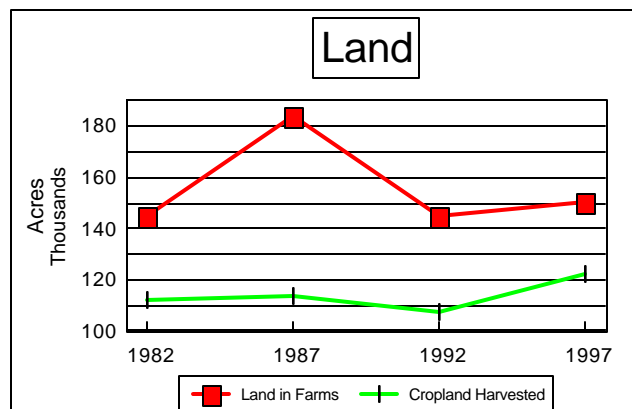
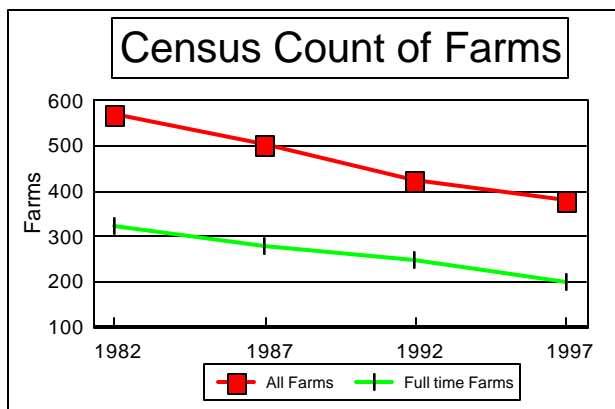
Increased 30 percent to \$48,056,000 in 1997.
