Market value of agricultural products sold

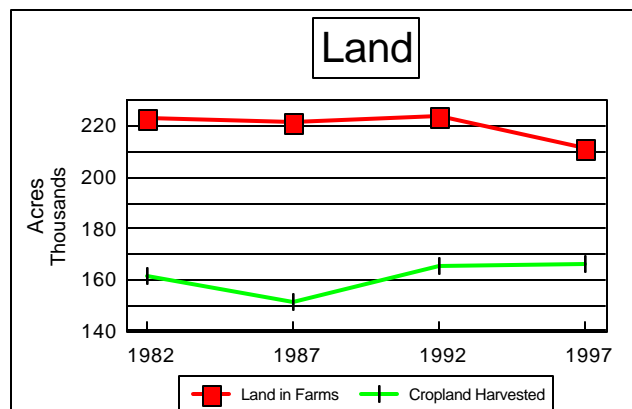
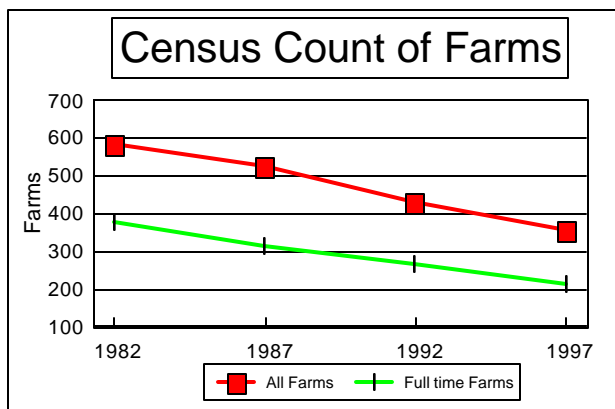
Increased 25 percent to \$63,051,000 in 1997.
