Land in farms

Increased 1 percent from 30,299 acres in 1992 to 30,683 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 8 percent from 71 acres in 1992 to 77 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased slightly from 144 farms in 1992 to 145 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

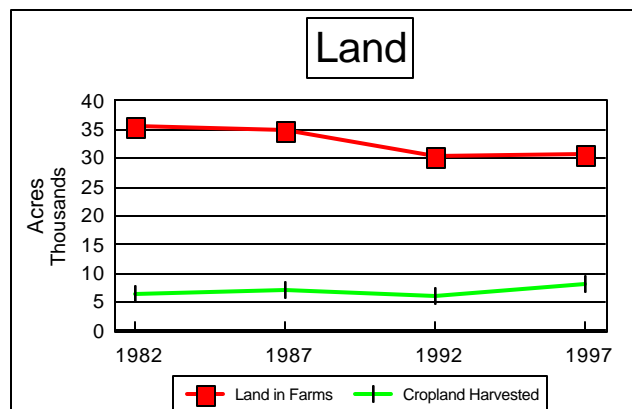
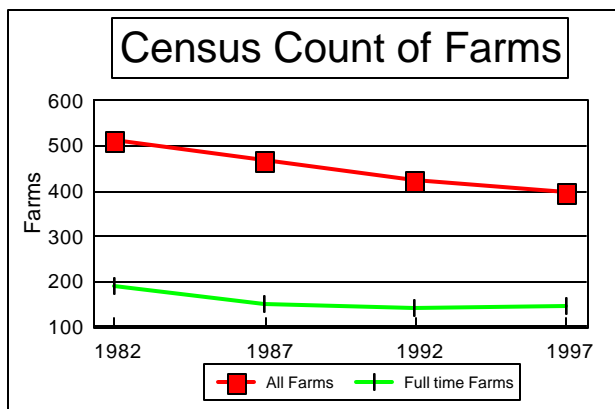
Decreased 29 percent to \$2,740,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 49 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 51 percent of the market value.
